

2017 DEFINITIONS OF SET SUBJECTS.

June 8th;

Isolation in the landscape/seascape.

A view of natural scenery featuring a **subject separate** from others, clearly isolated.

July 13th;

Shadows.

A shape(s) cast upon a surface by a body intercepting the rays of a source of light.

The shadows must be the subject of the image, not what is causing the shadow. (Reflections are not a Shadow)

Sept 14th;

Closeup.

An image taken very close up to the subject; an intimate view, but not necessarily macro.

Oct 26th;

People at work or play caught unawares or at **the moment** of awareness.
